

OCTOBER - DECEMBER 2024


GLOBAL DAY OF ACTION FOR CLIMATE JUSTICE

ISA participated the Global Day of Action for Climate Justice with advocates and church delegations in prayers and mobilization calling for the government to speed up the declaration of Climate Emergency on November 15, 2024. Cubao Bishop-Elect Elias Ayuban, Jr. CMF presided the Holy Mass and Fr. Juan Percy Bacani, MJ gave a very inspiring and challenging homily. The delegates marched from Claret Church in Diliman, Quezon City to PhilCoa where program was held. Representatives from different organizations gave a short speech. This event was organized by CMSP- Conference of Major Superiors in the Philippines, TFDP, Caritas Philippines, PMPI, FCCAI and ISA.



PUBLIC LECTURE 4

The Sr. Julie Postel Memorial Lecture for 2024 was held on November 23, 2024 via zoom with the topic "Spirituality and Synodality. The resource speakers were Dr. Jessica Joy Candelario and Dr. Estela Padilla. Dr. Padilla shared her personal experience during the Synod in Rome.
